Pile Burner Class

Pushed old trees piling up? Mongi Zekri is holding a Certified Pile Burner class on Wednesday, July 24, at the Southwest Florida Research and Education Center in Immokalee. This course will show you how to burn piles legally, safely and efficiently and could save a life. If you burn piles regularly, you should register for this course. When the weather is dry, certified pile burners receive priority for authorization to burn for the Florida Forest Service and you are are allowed to burn up to two hours longer per day and get multiple day authorizations.
